We are committed to providing specialized services that empower children, youth, and families in an inclusive, accessible, and safe environment.

What We Help With

At Cameray, we provide a number of types of counselling programs and support for families and children in Burnaby and New Westminster. A complete description of all of our programs, referral requirements, and availability is listed on our website.



COUNSELLING:

We offer many types of counselling programs to children, youth, and their families based on their needs: Family Program, Trauma Program, Sexual Abuse Intervention Program (SAIP), Sexual Health Intervention Program (SHIP), Child and Youth Mental Health (C&Y), and the High Risk Youth Program.

PARENT SUPPORT PROGRAM:

This program offers prevention and early intervention services to both parents of young children and parents-to-be that strengthen family resiliency. They are offered as individual parent support sessions as well as interactive and psycho-educational groups.

CHILD & YOUTH VICTIM SUPPORT SERVICE:

This program provides support and court preparation for children and youth who have witnessed or been the victim of a crime.



ACTS:

ACTS, or Assisting the Community with Transitioning Students, is for children in grades 5-7 to assist them with the transition to high school. It consists of Homework Clubs, mentorship, and special group activities.
