# SAS Program Focus:

Cameray's Sexual Assault Services Programs are designed to be inclusive and accessible to all individuals, regardless of gender, sexual orientation, race, ethnicity, ability, or background. Cameray celebrates diversity and are committed to creating a welcoming environment for all survivors.

Cameray aims to make both the Victim Services and Counselling Programs as accessible as possible. Support is available in a variety of formats (phone, in-person, and video) to meet the needs of survivors, regardless of their circumstances.

### What We Do:

Cameray offers support for individuals at any point in their recovery process. We provide a safe, non-judgemental space where you can share your experiences. Our staff are trained in trauma-informed care and will work with you at your pace. We offer confidential, one-on-one counselling services with a trained counsellor. Counselling is available at any stage of your healing journey and is designed to help survivors process their experiences in a safe, supportive environment.

#### **VICTIM SERVICES**

The Victim Support program is designed to provide survivors of sexual assault with compassionate, non-judgemental support, empowering individuals to make informed decisions about their healing journey. Support is available by phone, in-person and via video call.

### Services Include

- Emotional support is offered whether you are engaged with the criminal justice process or not.
- Assistance with safety planning and support.

- Accompaniment to court and or medical appointments or hospital visits.
- Help understanding the legal and justice process.
- Up-to-date information on the status of investigations and court cases.
- Support with filling out justicerelated paperwork.
- Resources and referrals to legal support, counselling, and other specialized services.



#### **COUNSELLING SERVICES**

The Counselling program provides flexible, individual, trauma-informed counselling services tailored to the needs of survivors of sexual assault. Our goal is to support you in navigating the emotional and psychological impacts of trauma, while fostering healing, resilience, and empowerment. Support is available by both in-person and video call.

### Services Include

Individual Counselling: A safe, private space to explore and work through the emotional and psychological effects of sexual assault.

Counselling services are rooted in trauma-informed care, ensuring your safety and control throughout the process. Resources and referrals, if additional support is needed, can be provided
